Saturday Open 5D:

- Saturday \$10,000 added money in the Open 5D, progressive format.
 - o Minimum \$5000 added money, progressive after each additional 100 runs
 - \$7500 added with 200 entries;
 - \$10,000 added with 300+ entries

Entries:

- Entries will be taken exclusively on Saddlebook
 - Credit card payments will incur a 3.0% credit card & 1.5% Saddlebook processing fee;
 - o Check payments will incur a 1.5% Saddlebook processing fee
- Checks will be accepted until April 12th:
 - o Checks received with a postmark date beyond April 12th not be accepted;
 - Entries paid by check with a postmark beyond April 12th must be immediately paid via credit card or entry will be canceled.
- Entries received after April 25th will incur a \$25 late fee:
 - o Only credit card payments will be accepted on Saddlebook after April 25th
 - On-site entries with credit card or cash only will be accepted
 - o Checks will not be accepted if postmarked after April 12th

- Returned NSF check fine is \$50

Draws:

- Draw #1 will include all entries submitted and paid by May 7th at midnight that did not select the "late draw" option in Saddlebook:
 - Draw #1 will be posted May 8th by 9:00 am on <u>Saddlebook</u> and will exclude entries marked as "late draw"
- Draw #2 will include all entries from May 8th -May 9th at midnight that did not select "late draw" option in Saddlebook:
 - o Draw #2 will be posted by May 10th at 9:00 am on Saddlebook
- The First Late draw will be done an hour before race start each day.
- Additional late draws will be done during the event as needed.

Late Entries:

- Will be accepted via Saddlebook up to the last 20 runs both days.
- Late entries after April 25th are subject to a \$25 late fee.
- If pre entered and enter another horse after books close you will incur a late fee on the additional horse.
- One late fee per rider, max.

Refunds:

- Draw outs will require a vet/medical release by May 11th, no later than the conclusion of the event.
- If a draw out is needed weekend of race, see the vet on site to get a vet slip.
- VET/MEDICAL SLIPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 11TH.
- No refunds will be issued without a vet/medical slip. Draw outs for reasons outside of documented vet/medical reasons will receive no refund.
- Refunds will be mailed after completion of race with a vet/medical release received by May 11th.
- Horse substitution is allowable and must notify the office <u>in person</u> with the registered name of the substitute horse prior to competing. If this is not done the run will be an automatic disqualification and fees forfeited.
- 75% refund on entry fee ONLY.
- No refund on credit card, Saddlebook processing fee or late fees.
- 100% refund on Stalls and RVs.
- Prior notice as stated above must be given. No shows will not be refunded.

Open 5D:

- 5D Format with 0.5, 1, 1.5 & 2 second splits.
- 75% payback.
- Course measurements will be posted at the office.
- Open awards for average on Friday and Saturday combined:
 - o Must be present or notify the office with name of person who will be accepting award(s) on your behalf
 - Must be in dress code. Awards photos are taken for sponsors
 - Awards will not be mailed
- Open 5D on Saturday, May 11 will run draw numbers 1-200. After rider 200, we will stop and prepare ground for 2D Sweepstakes at 6:00pm.
 - Resumption of Open 5D with draw 201-conclusion will be posted by April 30th

Sweepstakes:

- \$100 entry fee.
- 80% payback.
- 2D 0.75 split.
- Will run at 6 pm Saturday, May 11.

Stalls:

- Reserve Stalls via Saddlebook
- Stalls are required for \$35 per night.
 - Must declare if you are stalling a stallion
- Stalls are fully refundable.
 - Stalls cannot be resold to another person
 - o For stall refunds, please contact Emily at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com
 - o Prior notice is required for refunds on stalls. No shows will not be refunded
- No overnight tying to trailers or self-penning, per the facility.
- If you are arriving late, you must purchase stalls in advance of arrival.
 - Unless reserved and paid for, stalls will be locked

Shavings:

- No outside shavings, per facility.
- Stalls will include 1 bag of shavings.
- Additional bags can be pre purchased and will be available onsite for \$10 per bag.

Parking/Camping:

- Reserve RV space via <u>Saddlebook</u>.
- RV hook ups are \$35 per night.
- RVs are fully refundable.
 - RVs cannot be resold to another person
 - For RV refunds, please contact Emily at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com
 - o Prior notice is required for refunds on stalls. No shows will not be refunded
- RV spaces are limited and are on a first paid, first served basis.
- Dry camping is FREE.
- Once RV spots are sold out, we will set up Spider Box (power) reservations.
 - Spider Boxes will NOT support A/C units without blowing breakers. We will contact you to ask you if you
 want to proceed with the reservation or obtain a refund, if you choose to proceed you must adhere to the
 A/C rules, per the facility.
- PAID RV signs will be given upon check in at the office. These are required to be placed visibly in your vehicle or trailer window throughout the event.

Payouts:

- Checks will be mailed the following week of the event upon receipt of completed W9.
 - Checks will not be mailed until a current year W9 has been received
- Any balances owed will result in payoff checks being held until paid in full.
- Please be sure your correct mailing address is in Saddlebook when entering:
 - o Checks will be issued to the address listed in Saddlebook.

Multiple riders:

Horses cannot be run by multiple riders in same class/day.

Pee Wee:

- 10 & under as of Jan. 1st 2024.
- Guaranteed awards only, no payout:
 - Turn N Burn Barrel Racing LLC reserves the right to add jackpot pay-out to pee wee class at their discretion, with no change in entry fee.
- Pee Wee cannot enter the Open 5D on the same horse.

SIDE POTS

These side pots are a carryover from the Open 5D only and are available both days.

Youth:

- 17 and under as of Jan 1st 2024.
- 4D payout with ½ second splits.
- 75% payback.

Senior:

- 45 and over as of Jan 1st 2024.
- 4D payout with ½ second splits.
- 75% payback.

Your Barrel Connection (YBC) Side Pot:

- 4D option with ½ second splits.
- 70% payback.

Lucky #7 Side Pot:

- 3D format with 0.7 sec splits off fastest side pot 1D time.
- 75% payback.

Got A Little Tipsy Side Pot:

- Downed barrel(s) insurance pot.
- 3D format with 0.7 splits off the fastest time with a hit barrel(s).
- 75% payback

NWBIF:

- Northwest Barrel Incentive Fund
- 4D format with 0.5 splits
- 70% payback

Exhibitions:

- Will be in a Group Riding format.
- 15 min. intervals with maximum 5 riders available, per time slot.
- \$20 per time slot.
- If time slots fill, we will have a Group Riding waitlist on Saddlebook.
 - o If a Group Ride becomes available, we will contact you with the time(s) available.
- No refunds on Group Rides unless the office is able to fill your spot. Group Rides cannot be resold to another person.
- If you won't need or make your time slot <u>notify the office at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com</u> prior to May 10. Notification must be made in-person, at the office May 10-11. If we are able to find someone to fill your spot a refund will be made.
- For day of exhibitions, please check with gate person for availability and to purchase of Group Riding slots.
- Turn N Burn Barrel Racing LLC reserves the right to add additional Group Riding slots at their discretion.

No Time:

Contestants will receive a no time for knocking a barrel over or breaking the pattern.

Timers:

- An electric timer will be used.
- Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction.
- If a rerun is given, the contestant will choose from three options, and they must notify staff with rerun choice immediately.
 - Option 1: running the next available spot that matches draw position;
 - Option 2: run in late draw, keeping original draw position:;
 - Option 3: opt out, receive refund on entry fee for that run only. If carrying over to any side pots, refund would be issued for those as well. Excluding processing, late and credit card fees.

Drags:

- There will be a tractor drag after every 5 drawn runs.
- Big drag after every 50 drawn.
- Turn outs and releases will be included in the draw.
- The ground may be reworked at any time at the discretion of The Valor H committee for the safety of riders and horses.

Disqualification:

- Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be ready when called will result in disqualification.
- Announcer will call rider name three times, failure to be ready after 3rd call will result in disqualification.
- If a horse is run out of order, it will be disqualified.

Concessions:

• The Rim Rock Café will be open Friday and Saturday for your convenience.

Non-registered vendors:

- Will be charged double the regular vendor fee and disqualified without refunds if competing at the event.
- Providing any goods or services onsite is considered vending and is not allowed without registration.
 - No exceptions
 - This is to provide equity to the paying vendors supporting our race

Dogs:

- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- No dogs in the arena.
- Dogs creating conflict, excessive barking, or safety concerns may be asked to be contained at trailer or removed from premises.
