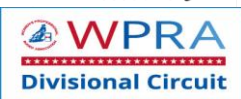

Barrel Racing Rules

DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, long-sleeved shirt, pants and boots are required.

Refund: Full refund less office fee will be granted before April 17th. After **April 17th** entry fee less office fee will only be refunded with a vet/medical release. Refunds will be mailed 10 days after completion of race with a vet/medical release. No Refunds in the Slot Race.

Slot Race: Slot race entries must be paid and postmarked by March 6th, 2020. No Refunds. Will run Open 5D with runners draw #1-#200 then start the Slot race at 4:00pm. The Open 5D will resume at 5:00 pm. May roll from Slot race to Saturday Open 5D. If entered in the X-treme Million Qualifier or Open 5-D you must run in the Saturday Slot race and roll your time to the X-treme Million Qualifier and/or the Open-5D for the day.

Entries: Must be postmarked by April 17th to be in draw 1 and 2 and to avoid the late fee. With the consolidation of Post Office locations and closing of Post Office Sorting Facilities-please be aware that mail deposited at some postal sites can take **2-3** days to be postmarked. We strongly recommend any payments sent on the 16th or 17th be mailed at the Post Office's inside counter with a hand stamped postmark to avoid any postmark delays that could have ramifications we are not responsible for. Can also enter online at www.turnnurnbarrelracing.com. Online entries accepted until April 22nd with late fee.

Open Barrel Race: 5D Format 1/2 second splits. Standard Barrel Pattern with 40 ft score.

Circling: One circle in the arena permitted prior to your approach to the first barrel.

Payments: Cash-Check- Credit Card (5% processing fee for Credit Card). **NO CHECKS ACCEPTED AFTER APRIL 17TH.**

Draw 1 and Draw 2 : NEW this year, we will be offering you a choice between Draw #1 and Draw #2 if you pre enter. Both draws will be posted on April 27th. For example if you are entering more than 1 horse but would like to know when your 2nd horse will be up prior to the race you can select Draw #1 for your first horse and Draw #2 for your second horse. With this option you will be able to pre enter and know when you will be up prior to the late draw. Will be posted online at www.turnnurnbarrelracing.com and www.besthorsegear.com April 27th.

Late Entries: Will be accepted up to the last 20 runs both days. Late entries are subject to late fees. Paper late entries, stalls, RV spots after April 17th will only be accepted onsite at the office. Online entries accepted until April 22nd with late fee, will be in 1st late draw. If pre entered and enter another horse after books close you will incur a late fee on the additional horse. One late fee per rider max.

Exhibitions: Will be in a Group Riding format, 15 min. intervals with 5 riders available per slot with 1 min rakes between each slot. \$20 per slot. No refunds can sell to another rider but must notify gate person.

RV Camping: If RV camping was selected on entry form a card will be issued and it must be placed in a visible location. No charge for Dry Camping (Parking Lot Only)

No Time: Contestants will receive a no time for knocking a barrel over or breaking the pattern.

Timers: An electric timer will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction. If a rerun is given, it will be up to the contestant to decide when the rerun will take place; they must notify staff with rerun choice immediately. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestant's equipment breaking off or a rider's decision to pull up.

Drags: There will be a drag after every 5 numbers and a big drag every 50. We will do a Big drag at #200, run the Slot Race then do another Big drag before #201.

Disqualification: Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be in position in the holding area will result in a disqualification. Contestants must be in holding pen during your drag. If a horse is ran out of order, it will be disqualified. Announcer will call rider name three times, failure to be ready after 3rd call will be a turnout.

Stalls & Shavings: No outside shavings per facility. Stalls will include 1 bag of shavings for the 1st night only. Additional bags can be purchased for \$10 on site. Stalls required, no tie outs or self pen per facility. Assignments are made as they are received and posted to our website. If you require additional stalls at a later date we will make every effort to keep all stalls together but can not be guaranteed. (reserve early to avoid this issue)

Non registered vendors will be charged double the regular vendor fee and disqualified without refunds if competing at event. If you receive money for any goods or service you are considered a vendor. No exceptions.

Future Fortunes: 4D option ½. You must provide a copy of Registration Papers, Future Fortunes entry form and W9. If you are not sure if your horse is paid into FF go to their website www.futurefortunesinc.com and you can look up your horses registered name. Checks will be mailed by Future Fortunes Inc. two weeks after results are received and posted by Future Fortunes.

Judge Cash Sidepot: No entry fee, \$100 to each D winner. 5D ½ sec splits. You must provide a copy of Registration Papers and roll your time from the Open 5D.

YBC Sidepot: 4D option ½. Your Barrel Connections Sidepot. Must roll time from Open.

Xtreme Million Entries: The X-treme Million Qualifier is a **ROLL** only from the Open-5-D on Friday, the Slot race or Open 5-D on Saturday. Slot racers must RUN in the Slot race. Entries for the Xtreme Mill will taken at www.saddlebook.com

Xtreme Bonus Bucks Side Pot: XBB select Xtreme Sanctioned events will have a XBB side pot. 5D ½ splits. Entries for the XBB will be taken on www.saddlebook.com (entries must be received online before you run in the sanctioned event). Xtreme will send the winners of the XBB side pot their winnings. XBB: \$35 EF for every 10 runners Xtreme will add \$50 to the XBB side pot. The XBB will count for 1 qualification; you will receive 50 participation points and 1 point for every dollar earned. Must be a member, roll your time from the open and pay the \$3 co-sanction fee. www.burnsevents.com for membership forms.

NBHA Senior Race & NBHA Youth Race: 4D option ½, Senior 50 & over, Youth 18 & under. Do not need to be NBHA member to enter. Must roll time from Open.

BSCC race Sunday May 3rd \$1000 added 4D. Entering all 3 races, May 1st, May 2nd and May 3rd will qualify you for the BSCC Finals October 2nd-4th Crook County Fairgrounds, Prineville, OR.

 - Designate FF horse and use horse's registered name on the producer entry form.
 - Provide a copy of horse's registration papers from a recognized breed association showing the current owner with each entry.
 - Submit a FF entry form that is on our website at each event.
 - Each owner must have a current W9 on file with Future Fortunes before checks are mailed.
 - Foreign entries must have a W-8 BEN on file with Future Fortunes before checks are mailed.
- Each Participant in FUTURE FORTUNES Stallion Incentive Program covenants and agrees that he/she will not at any time, through any medium, either orally or in writing engage in prohibited communications—including but not limited to email, Facebook and other social media, internet forums, blogs, or television or radio—disparage, defame, impugn, damage or assail the reputation, or cause or tend to cause the recipient of a communication to question the integrity, competence, good character, or professionalism, of FUTURE FORTUNES, Inc., provided that nothing shall prohibit a Participant from communicating truthfully to such Participant's legal counsel or as otherwise required by law or order of court.
